Catering Tender Rules and Regulations

1. Applicant should have an experience of at least 5 years of running a similar business.
2. Applicant should be Indian citizen/national.
3. Applicant should give competitive rates in comparison to existing rate card/menu.
4. The decision of Mumbai Press Club shall be final and binding on every applicant.
5. Mumbai Press Club holds the right to cancel bids/tenders received by any or all applicants at any points, without assigning any reason.
6. Once approved and accepted, the contract shall be valid for a period of two years. This can be extended at the pleasure of Mumbai Press Club Managing Committee.
7. The applicant shall also have to take care of 32 Press Club staff's Lunch, Dinner and daily tea and snacks.
8. In any legal dispute, the jurisdiction will be Mumbai city (island city).
9. The bid winner shall be required to deposit Rs 5 lakhs. The deposit will be refundable, and returned without any interest levied after completing the agreement period.
10. Both parties shall have the right to terminate contract by serving a 2 month prior notice.
11. Mumbai Press Club shall charge some amount for power consumption in the kitchen and maintenance cost of the kitchen.
12. Mumbai Press Club has its own waiting staff to serve the food. It has its crockery, cutlery and domestic appliances (will be open for inspection).
13. The caterer shall be responsible for hygiene and food quality thereof, and held responsible in case any incident of food poisoning is reported by the clients. The Club management shall not be held responsible for any such incident.
14. Mumbai Press Club shall have the right to fulfill catering needs from any other service provider during some special occasions. However, the first priority will be given to the Club's catering contractor.
15. The club recovers the pending bill from members, and makes a monthly payment to the caterer.
